Sri PARITOSH BISWAS is a progressive farmer of village MV-7 of Malkangiri district and owned 10.0 acres of land where he used to grow HYV rice in 6.5 acre, vegetables 2.0 acre and other 1.5 acre under fish farming(IMC) . He got trained from KVK in Mushroom production and growing Sweet corn (1.0 ac) and Cabbage and Cauliflower cultivation (1.0 ac) for higher income. He is rearing 50 no of Vanaraja poultry and growing mushroom 200 beds per year . The marketability of the product is also encouraging in the nearby areas and he has developed good linkage with all developmental departments and he is a member of local vegetable growers association . His annual income from agriculture, Horticulture, Animal Husbandry, and Fishery components is Rs. 8.5 lakh per year. He has received State level Best Farmer Award in OUAT Foundation Day in the year 2021

Adoption of New Technology like Pond Based Integrated Farming System, Agriculture , Vegetables grower , Fish farming , Poultry and growing cash crops like Sweet corn and Cole crops and Mushroom

Outcome of the technologies adopted for enhancing farm income

- ✚ Cultivation of HYV paddy var. Sahabhagi dhan , Hasanta , MTU- 1001, Pooja is cultivated an area 6.0 acre, With gross income is 1.80 lakh and Sesame var-GT-10 with area 7.0 acre, with net annual income Rs 1.0 lakhs.
- ✚ He is growing high value vegetable crops like Knol khol, Cowpea, Water melon, Ridge gourd , Sweet corn cultivation and bitter gourd in an area of 2.0 acre and getting gross return Rs.2.0 lakh /annum, and also a active member local vegetable producer group producer .
- ✚ He has taken up Cabbage & Cauliflower cultivation in an area of 1.0 acre since last three years and getting annual income of Rs.1.2lakh per annum. He is also having HYV mango orchard comprising 40 nos of fruiting plant and he is getting a net return of Rs. 40,000/-
- ✚ He has also adopted different income generating activities like Mushroom cultivation (200 beds/year), and dairy farming (Two nos mulching CB cows) and backyard poultry Desi and Vanaraja-50nos with annual income of Rs.1.2 lakh. With addition to it he is involved in Fish farming (IMC) in his three numbers of ponds with an area 1.5 acre, with gross return of Rs.90,000/- return per year .
- ✚ He has owned some agriculture assets like tractor with power operated paddy thresher and also sharing the implements among the villages on custom hiring basis
